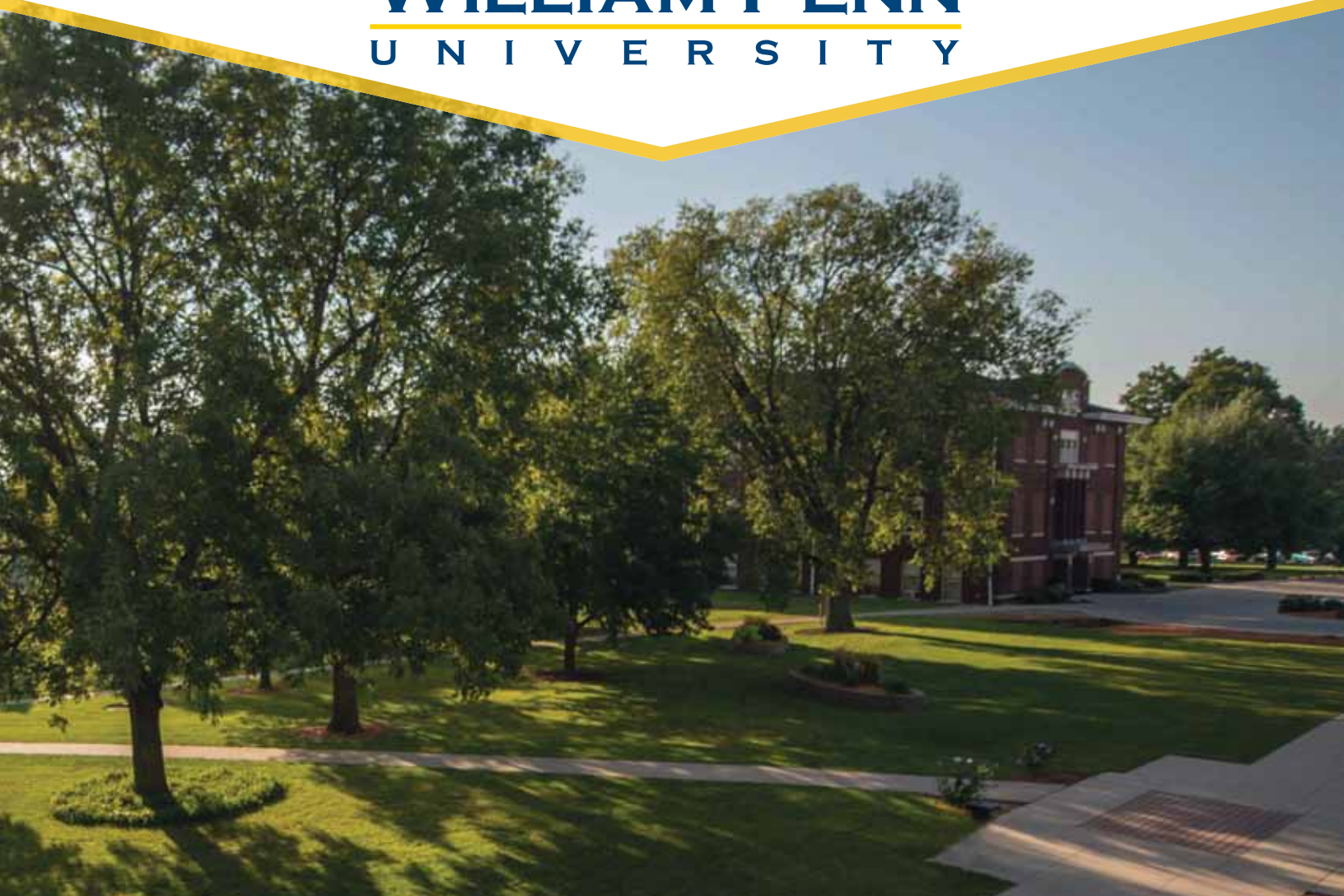

Ray Blue was a cast member of the "Ray Charles Show" which toured in Germany, Switzerland, Austria, and Italy from 2008 to 2010. In addition, Ray Blue has shared the stage with John Gilmore, Dr. Art Davis, Benny Powell, Eddie Henderson, Kirk Lightsey, Charlie Persip Super Band, Clifford Adams, Wycliff Gordon, Bernard Purdie, Steve Turre, Ted Curson, Joe Lee Wilson, Alicia Keys, The Sun Ra Arkestra, Cotton Club All Stars, and many others.

He is the founder of Cross-Cultural Connection, Inc.—a non-profit organization that promotes jazz culture, performance, and education. At William Penn, the annual "The Ray Blue Jazz Award" is given to a graduating senior in Ray Blue's honor.
